## Santa Ynez River Road, Mutau/Thorn Meadow Road and Rose Valley Road Maintenance and Erosion Repair

### DESCRIPTION/SPECIFICATIONS/STATEMENT OF WORK

#### SCOPE OF CONTRACT

##### Base:

The purpose of this contract is to reconstruct the storm damaged sections of Santa Ynez River Road near Cachuma Lake area within the Los Padres National Forest on the Santa Barbara Ranger District. There are four main sites of repair. The first site consists of building a concrete block wall, filling/compacting sub-base, laying asphalt, and re-establishing embankment. The second site consists of removal of damaged overside drain, installing new over side drain and re-establishing embankment. The third site consists of removing damaged culvert, installing new culvert, asphalt patching and re-establishing embankment. The fourth site consist of asphalt patching.

This contract provides for the equipment, labor, materials, services and permits necessary to perform work ordered by the Government, in compliance with its terms, specifications, drawings and provisions. All sites need to adhere to FS 990a for Best Management Practices.

##### Option 1:

The purpose of this contract is to reconstruct the storm damaged sections of Mutau Road and Thorn Meadow roads near the Frazier Park area within the Los Padres National Forest on the Mt Pinos Ranger District. The work consists of importing unclassified fill dirt, compact storm damaged erosion ditch, asphalt patch, and repair overside drains.

This contract provides for the equipment, labor, materials, services and permits necessary to perform work ordered by the Government, in compliance with its terms, specifications, drawings and provisions.

##### Option 2:

The purpose of this contract is to patch asphalt potholes on two (2) roads on the Los Padres National Forest within the Ojai Ranger District. The 2 locations are Rose Valley Road and Lyon Canyon Road.

**A site visit is encouraged to see the actual conditions, quantities, and access to the area. At the time of this contract preparation Hwy 33 from Ojai was not open to the public and all access was from the North off Hwy 166.** This contract provides for the equipment, labor, and services necessary to perform work ordered by the Government for road maintenance on unsurfaced roads, in compliance with the terms, specifications, drawings and provisions of this contract. Locations of work will be directed by the Forest Service.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

The Contractor shall furnish the necessary personnel, material, equipment, services and facilities to perform the Statement of Work/Specifications referenced below.

The Contractor shall minimize mechanical activity during rainy periods and the CO may shut down the operation if excessive soil disturbance and/or erosion problems occur.

The Contractor shall repair all associated damage on established roads, adjacent vegetation or other improvements caused by their operations or equipment prior to partial or final payment.

The Contractor shall provide technical submittals for all materials that may be furnished on this project for Forest Service review and approval prior to installation.

The Contractor shall dispose of all project related trash and debris off Forest lands prior to final payment.

## **Santa Ynez River Road, Mutau/Thorn Meadow Road and Rose Valley Road Maintenance and Erosion Repair**

The Contractor is responsible for contacting the Forest dispatch center to obtain the fire predicted Project Activity Level (PAL) each day and restrict work accordingly.

The Contractor shall adhere to the pertinent requirements addressed in the Fire Plan. Fire Plan restrictions may require work to cease at 1:00 pm or not be initiated at all on a high fire activity day.

The Contractor is responsible for traffic control and equipment staging requirements in work areas when working on National Forest System Lands.

The Contractor shall provide clean equipment for the project prior to driving on Forest to prevent the introduction of invasive weeds to the Forest.
